## Important notes:

- 1. A foreign applicant must have completed twelve (12) years of schooling. Applicant must pass courses of science group equivalent to Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC/12<sup>th</sup> Grade) of Bangladesh with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology and obtained division/grade as those for HSC in Bangladesh.
- 2. The applicant must submit a scanned copy of all certificates and transcripts of 12<sup>th</sup> grade educational qualification with the application.
- Candidate shall have to submit an authorized health certificate as proof of his/her not being suffering from any communicable/contagious disease or such disorders, mental or physical, which may impede his/her curricular activities at this University.
- 4. The applicant shall have to produce a certificate of proficiency in English.
- 5. The Dean of the respective Faculty will verify the Certificates and Transcripts and determine the applicant's minimum standard of merit. Then he/she may be recommended for an admission test.

- 6. The Admission Committee of the respective Faculty will take the online admission test of the applicant.
- 7. Candidates who will pass the admission test will be sent an offer letter for admission.
- After receiving the offer letter, the eligible candidate has to apply for admission in the prescribed form through the Bangladeshi Embassy in his/her country. The prescribed form has to be filled out properly and submitted along with the required documents to the Bangladeshi Embassy in his/her country.
- 9. After receiving the application form to the Bangladesh Agricultural University through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the candidate will be given a final letter for admission. After receiving the final letter, the candidate has to complete the admission process by appearing in person at Bangladesh Agricultural University on the scheduled date.
- 10. The candidate has to attest all academic certificates and mark sheets/transcripts from the Foreign/Education Ministry of his/her country and submit the original copy at the time of admission.

#### **Accommodation:**

There are 9 (Nine) Halls of residence for boys and 5 (Five) for girls. As the number of seats for foreigners in these Halls is limited, there is no guarantee of a seat.
